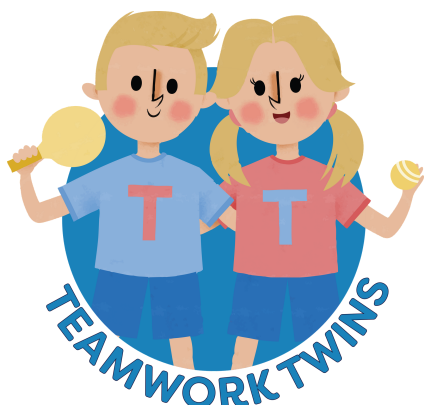
WELCOME BACK

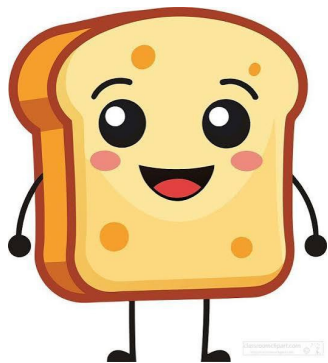


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BREAKFAST CLUB

BEHAVIOUR TIP

Postpone decisions: When it comes to consequences, get used to saying, 'I need to think about what happens next' or 'Let's come back to it later'. It is important that your response to tricky behaviour is well considered, fair and proportionate. Reacting in the moment rarely allows us to give this response to our children.
